

We have a team of Heroes that serve you every week! Would you like to be a Hero? As we prepare to utilize our new building we have opportunities for you to become a Hero too.

Kids Ministry Volunteers:

SUNDAY: Services at 9:00 & 11:00 am. Leaders are asked to be 15 minutes early and stay about 15 minutes after. Commitment could be once a month to every Sunday depending on your preference.

Nursery workers: Childcare for kids 0-2 years old.

Preschool teachers and helpers: Teach or assist the teacher for age specific classes of kids ages 2-5.

Kids Church helpers: Assist in various roles during Sunday morning services @ 9 & 11 am
Options: 1) Crowd control 2) Teach object lessons, or Bible stories, or games.

WEDNESDAY: Time Commitment: 6:15-8:15 pm. Assistants are asked to help once a month to every week depending on your preference.

Royal Ranger helpers: Assist commanders in the age-specific classes for boys.

Girls Ministry helpers: Assist teachers in the age-specific classes for girls

Preschool helpers: Assist teachers in the age-specific classes.

Nursery Workers: Childcare for 0-2 year olds.

SECURITY TEAM: 1-2 people to monitor the children's wing during Sunday and Wednesday services. Rotating schedule, typically once a month.

Worship Team Volunteers:

Vocalists and musicians are added to our worship team through an application and audition process. Audition appointments are scheduled through Amanda Keller.

Tech Team Volunteers:

SUNDAY: Commitment could be once a month to every Sunday depending on your preference.

7:30 am – end of 2nd service

Lighting Tech: Run lighting for the service.

ProPresenter Tech: Run slides for display in services.

Sound Tech: Run sound for services.

8:30 am – end of 2nd service

Camera operators: Operate camera for live streaming.

Video Switcher: Operate the Video Switcher for live streaming.

Production Assistant: 7:30 am through the end of second service. Assist the Worship Pastor in making sure that all service elements are being accomplished in a timely manner.

Remedy Youth Volunteers:

WEDNESDAY: Service at 6:30-8:15 pm

Seasonal commitment (3 months+)

Check in/registration: Use a check-in system on an iPad at each entrance to take attendance of students and to check in visiting parents or approved life church staff.

Snack shop worker: Selling all things candy, pop, and many more snacks. There may be youth apparel students can buy.

Production crew: Assisting a team of students to run the worship/sermon slides, light system, and sound system for the worship set.

Red carpet team: This is the greeting team, first smile & high five a student gets when walking through our doors. You'll also be in the New Student VIP lounge to make new students feel welcome, like a VIP!

Game manager: Assisting Pastor Colin by coming up with and helping run ice breaker games to play during service on a weekly basis as well as come up with a list of games for special events (Holiday party, color wars, etc.)

Security: Keeping unapproved adults out (People who aren't parents or approved volunteers), monitoring student activity inside making sure they stay and act safe.

STAFF TEAM: School year - 1 year commitments

*Requires interview with Youth Pastor

Discipleship, accountability partners: This is a vital role. You will be someone that meets with 1 or a few students on a regular basis to keep them accountable and be a mentor to them.

Chaperones: (if available)

You are the first pool of people to be able to attend district youth events as a chaperone.

Small group leaders:

You and another leader will lead small group discussion times, helping ask questions and keeping student conversation on track.

First Impressions Volunteers:

Greeters: Greet people as they enter the building and enter the sanctuary. Arrive 30 minutes before service and greet through the service you are scheduled. Rotating schedule, typically once to twice a month.

Head Usher: Hand out bulletins at the door as people arrive. Assist in taking offering and/or communion. Check list of assigned volunteers and make sure ushers and greeters are in place, if anyone is missing ask for volunteers to fill in. Rotating schedule, typically once to twice a month.

Ushers: Hand out bulletins at the door as people arrive. Assist in taking offering and/or communion. Sundays at 8:30 or 10:30 am through the service. Rotating schedule, typically once to twice a month.

Communion Team: Prepare the communion cups and wafers. Arrive 60 minutes before service and prepare the elements for both services. Rotating schedule typically three times per year.

Coffee Team: Keep Coffee filled at the Beverage Stations throughout the morning. Sundays 8:00 am-11:30 am. Rotating schedule, typically once a month.

First Impressions Scheduling Team: Use Planning Center to schedule volunteers for Sunday Services. This position can be done from home and will take about two hours a week. This is every week for three months commitment.

Hub Information Booth Team: Greet guests at the Information Booth, give 1st time guest a gift, answer any questions guests may have about weekly activities (Don't worry, we give you all the information you need to share with them).
